1. Trees:

- b. Once these 50 trees are completely planted, more trees will be added when funds are available and when the Heritage Festival Committee has an idea of where they will have the activities set up.

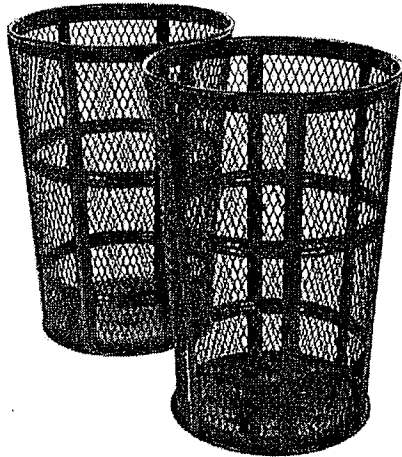
3. Picnic Areas:

- c. Recycle Benches – Stephanie Guy was able to find a grant from the Kansas Department of Health and Environment for Recycle Benches. She would like to purchase 8 recycle benches for Memorial Park. The forms will need to be post marked by Feb 1st and if we are awarded the funds, we will receive 50% of the purchase and installation of the benches. We will be contacted in April if awarded.
- d. Metal Benches – Robert Bell, from Andale, quoted 5 each of 5 ft metal benches for \$450 each. The benches will have "Veteran's Park" on the back and an emblem of a military branch. Terry Spexarth would like to have Willie Gondoly see how much it would cost for us to make them since ICM has a plasma cutter. Willie is working on the quote.

4. Memorial Park Entrance Sign:

- a. Chief Hinkle received a quote from Nu-Line Signs for \$2,385.00. Sharon to contact them to see a model.
